Chapter 3 Abstract Small fiber neuropathy (SFN) is a neuropathy selectively involving small diameter myelinated and unmyelinated nerve fibers. Interest in this disorder has considerably increased during the past few years. It is often idiopathic and typically presents with peripheral pain and/or symptoms of autonomic dysfunction.

There are many types of peripheral neuropathy, often brought on by diabetes; genetic predispositions (hereditary causes); exposure to toxic chemicals, alcoholism, malnutrition, inflammation (infectious or autoimmune), injury, and nerve compression; and by taking certain medications such as those used to treat cancer and HIV/AIDS.

Peripheral nerve diseases are very uncommon, except in the elderly population, and in many cases the aetiology remains unknown despite investigations. In certain situations a nerve biopsy may be helpful in the investigation of patients, particularly where there is a reasonable likelihood of detecting a treatable disorder, and a skin biopsy may also help in confirming the presence of a small fibre neuropathy.
